I spent this past fall semester studying abroad in Costa Rica. After learning about field study opportunities in the rainforest, it was undeniable that I wanted to study in Cost Rica. As a double major in environmental science and biology, these hands-on experiences in the rainforest were perfect for my future career goals. My Costa Rican heritage was also an important factor in my decision to study abroad. It was an incredible experience being able to reconnect with various family members still living there, as well as being introduced to the culture and all that Costa Rica has to offer. 
Upcoming Academic Programs at Rider
