Tuition Fees

If your university has a mutual exchange partnership with St Mary's University then you may be eligible for a tuition fee waiver. In order to begin your study abroad application as an exchange student, you must be nominated by your home institution and be enrolled at an existing partner institution.

2017/18 fees (subject to confirmation):

One semester – £5,610
Academic Year – £11,220

Students have three accommodation options (subject to confirmation):

De Marillac Hall – £3,600

Waldegrave Park Hall – £3,000

Twin rooms with shared bathroom facilities

Homestay – £2,900

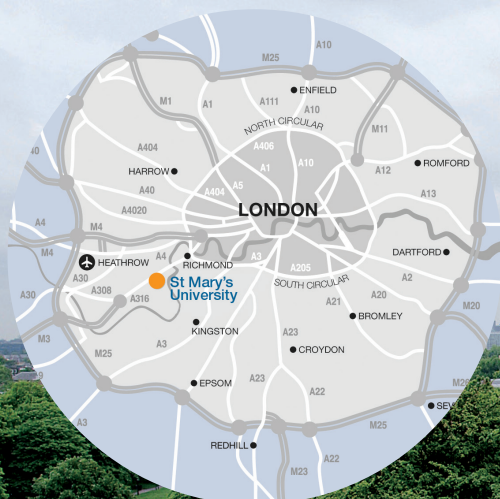
Live locally to campus with a host family

Campus Location

Situated in London's leafy borough of Richmond upon Thames, our campus boasts all the perks of a great city location with easy access to central London whilst maintaining the peace and tranquillity of a self-contained campus.



Airport Pick-up Service

An airport pick-up from Heathrow to campus will be arranged and is available for all Study Abroad students arriving on the set arrival date by the designated time.



Social Programme

An optional social programme will be available for students to purchase before arrival. Visa Requirements

Students whose nationality is outside the European Union will require a Visa to study in the United Kingdom. There are two Visa routes outlined below:

Tier 4 – This visa is for Study Abroad students whose nationality is outside the European Union and intend to study at St Mary's for a full academic year or are taking a workplace learning (Internship) class.

Short Term Study Visa – This Visa is for Study Abroad students whose nationality is outside the European Union and study at St Mary's for one semester and do not intend to take the workplace learning (internship) class.



Entry Requirements and Application Process

Academic Requirements

To apply for the Study Abroad programme students must have completed at least one academic year at University level and have achieved a minimum 2.7 GPA equivalent.

English Language Requirements

Students from non-native English speaking countries must be able to prove English Language proficiency.

We require students to have a minimum overall 6.0 IELTS score with no component of the assessment below 5.5.
